#### **Attendance and Punctuality**

Unfortunately, we didn't hit our target of 95.5% attendance this year. Our draft attendance for 2017-18 is 94.7%. Regular attendance and punctuality are important if children are to take part fully in the life of the school and to take advantage of the learning opportunities offered by the school. We recognise that attending school regularly and punctually is vital to the educational process and encourages a good pattern of work.

As a result, improving attendance and punctuality will be a school priority again this year and will be closely monitored by the school and authority.

The bell will ring at 8.55am. All pupils are expected to be on the school premises by this time. If your child arrives after the register is taken at 9am, they will be recorded as arriving late. I have no choice but to pass on the information of pupils who are frequently late to Child Services.

#### Absence due to illness:

- 1. It is imperative that parents provide an explanation on the first day your child is absent. You are requested to notify the school before 9.15am. Unless we receive a telephone call, message or a visit from the parent, then your child's absence will be registered as unauthorised.
- 2. You are requested to send a note of explanation on the day your child returns to school. This will provide us with appropriate records.
- 3. Regular absences will be referred to the School Nurse and Educational Social Worker

#### **POLITE REQUESTS**

#### Could you please:

- **1.** Ensure your children arrive at school on time.
- **2.** Ensure all clothing and footwear is labelled.
- **3.** Ensure your child brings their reading diary or log to school every day.
- **4.** Ensure your child is not left alone on the school yard before 8.45am.
- **5.** Ensure your child doesn't bring in lots of baggage we don't have room on the pegs. A book bag and small PE kit bag will suffice.
- 6. PE kit to be available in school all week. Bring to school on a Monday and take home on Friday.
- 7. Try to join Class Dojo as this is our main channel for us to share information and we love sharing our teaching and learning activities with you. Please do not use Class Dojo to report an absence or air a grievance I have asked staff not to respond to grievances made on Dojo. Staff will only respond to messages during working hours (8.30am 4.30pm).
- 8. Support us with our school rules Be Ready, Respectful and Safe.
- **9.** Avoid parking on the staff car park in the mornings I need staff in work on time and not having to find parking spots!
- 10. Ensure pupils wear the stipulated school uniform. Please see our online prospectus for the uniform list.
